

ROBYN HOOD

Robyn Loxley is a woman with a secret. While her activist mother Tressie Loxley works to save their home Sherwood Towers from greedy property developer John Prince, Robyn feigns disinterest while secretly recording underground videos with her friends – Much and Alan Dale – who form the masked band known as The Hood.

But Robyn's life changes forever when John Prince, angered by Tressie's latest protest, enlists the ice-cold Sheriff of New Nottingham to arrest Tressie - an operation that ends in tragedy and changes Robyn and her mother's lives forever. Despite the help of Marian, Tressie's pro-bono lawyer, Robyn and her sister, Jill Scarlett, are unable to free their mother from the Sheriff's incarceration. Worse, Robyn learns that Prince and the Sheriff plan to murder Tressie to silence her. To keep her family safe from the Sheriff and her community out of Prince's clutches, Robyn and The Hood pledge to rob from the rich and give to the poor as they fight the injustices of New Nottingham.



LEONARD COHEN: IF IT BE YOUR WILL

Leonard Cohen is one of the greatest songwriters of all time. No Way To Say Goodbye offers us a profound insight into the life of Leonard Cohen and why he is an incredibly revered songwriter. A year to the day after his passing, some of the world's most beloved performers gathered in his hometown Montreal to pay tribute to their hero. Backed by a full orchestra, Leonard's band, and a star-studded line-up including Sting, Elvis Costello, k.d. lang, Lana del Rey, The Lumineers, Damien Rice, Patrick Watson, Adam Cohen, and Courtney Love. performed some of Leonard's most exalted songs to a spellbound audience. The film includes rare footage of Leonard himself talking candidly, eloquently, and wittily, as always - about his literary, musical, and spiritual experience, culminating in his phenomenal return to the stage at the end of his life. WAR GAME

WAR GAME was the #1 Documentary on digital for Amazon Prime and Apple TV.

A bipartisan group of U.S. defense, intelligence, and elected policymakers spanning five presidential administrations participate in an unscripted role-play exercise in which they confront a political coup backed by rogue members of the U.S. military, in the wake of a contested presidential election.

Award-winning filmmakers Jesse Moss and Tony Gerber seize a unique opportunity to bring audiences tableside to a simulation that dramatically escalates the threat posed by January 6, 2021. With the grip of a thriller, War Game posits active-duty military breaking ranks to join an insurrection that soon spreads to other state capitals, yielding a chilling moment when it's unclear whether the president fully commands the armed forces. The simulation's outcome hinges on several inflection points, from the government's capacity to counter the disinformation that's effectively spread by the insurgent side to the potential invocation of the Insurrection Act (i.e., the last resort). While the exercise served to stress test our institutions, the film is a critical wake-up call, underscoring the urgent need for bipartisanship in safeguarding American democracy.
